If purchasing credits from the Half Mile Lane Project and the Oregon Rapid Wetland Assessment Protocol (ORWAP) was the functional assessment method used to evaluate the impact site, include a copy of ORWAP with your reservation form. Half Mile Lane is a pilot project for the Willamette Partnership's Counting on the Environment program and the number of credits required for mitigation will be based on the impact location and functions lost.

## Important Notes about Credit Requests, Reservations, and Purchases

- 1. Staff will attempt to process the application within 5 business days of receiving a complete credit reservation application. The mitigation specialist will conduct a preliminary review to assess whether the in-lieu fee project will replace the type (e.g. wetland HGM and Cowardin class) of water resource that will be impacted and has a service area that includes the project site, and whether any private bank also serves the area. After processing the application, the mitigation specialist will notify the Applicant whether an in-lieu fee site is appropriate and has enough credits to service the request.
- 2. Credits will be reserved for the Applicant's project for up to 180 calendar days from the date the request was received. If credits are not currently available, DSL will place the applicant on a waiting list based on the date the application was received.
- 3. If the 180-day period lapses and the credits have not been purchased, the credits will no longer be reserved for the Applicant and may be allocated to other customers that may be on the waiting list.
- 4. During the permit application completeness review, a DSL resource coordinator will determine whether the proposed credit purchase provisionally meets the compensatory mitigation requirements for the proposed impact. The results of that review will be included in the completeness review and communicated to the Applicant.
- 5. DSL has a "no competition" clause for the In-Lieu Fee Program. Once an application is deemed complete by the resource coordinator, the application is circulated for public review. The day that the public review period closes will be used to determine whether competition with a private mitigation bank exists. If there is competition, the applicant will be notified that use of in-lieu fee credits will not be acceptable and DSL will direct the applicant to purchase credits from the private supplier, even if credit costs are higher. If no competition exists, in-lieu fee credits may be used and this decision will hold even if bank credits become available at a later date (e.g. prior to permit issuance). The exception may be if the permit is modified and results in additional mitigation requirements.
- 6. Credits may be purchased at any time during the 180-day reservation period. However, it is highly recommended that the Applicant wait until immediately before permit issuance to complete the sale. (Credit purchase before final review is near completion is at the Applicant's own risk. Applicants should coordinate with the Corps of Engineers to be sure that the credit purchase will also satisfy federal mitigation requirements). **Please contact the DSL In-Lieu Fee Mitigation Specialist for a payment invoice when ready to purchase.** Payments may be made by credit card by calling (503) 986-5253, or by sending the form and a check payable to Oregon Department of State Lands and mailed to:

7. Upon confirmation of purchase, DSL will provide a bill of sale to the Applicant, Authorized Agent, the DSL Resource Coordinator, and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers as proof of mitigation credit purchase.
