

Astri Kimball is Senior Policy Counsel at Google in Washington, DC, focused on working with the US government on Google's global policy challenges and opportunities.

Prior to joining Google, Ms. Kimball served for six years in the Obama Administration, including the White House and the Overseas Private Investment Corporation (OPIC). In the White House, Ms. Kimball was Deputy Director of Cabinet Affairs for President Obama and then Deputy Counsel to Vice President Biden. As a member of the senior management team of OPIC, Ms. Kimball focused on President Obama's Power Africa initiative, impact investing, and opening OPIC's first-ever office in Asia, in Bangkok.

Ms. Kimball previously worked in the International Dispute Resolution and Strategic Counseling practice groups at O'Melveny and Myers, LLP, and at Goldman Sachs in New York.

Ms. Kimball is a Term Member of the Council on Foreign Relations and Co-Chair of the Meridian Center Rising Leaders Council. She is a Board member of the DC Public Library Foundation and Advancing Girls' Education in Africa (AGE) and has been a mentor with First Lady Michelle Obama's mentorship program for girls.

Ms. Kimball is a graduate of Princeton University and New York University School of Law. She is a member of the New York and Washington, DC bars and has published articles with Brookings, the World Economic Forum, and the Aspen Institute.
