

### Climate change in Minnesota




- Warmer and wetter



## Climate change: Duluth urban streams




Maximum




#### Skunk Creek Nine Key Element Plan

- "...three rainfall events in the past three years that have exceeded the 200-year storm event..."
- "Increased volumes and rates of runoff and stream-flow that have altered the channel stability and evolution of Elim Creek."

Critical area	Activity
Failing red clay dams	Dam removal
Improperly sized culverts	Culvert replacement
Near-channel erosion	Stream channel restoration and riparian management

# Sediment source: stream bank erosion and altered hydrology

- Near-channel practices
- Soil health practices
- Agricultural BMPs

#### Monitoring

- Long-term stream flow and water quality monitoring
  - Cooperative Stream Gaging (DNR/MPCA/USGS)
  - Watershed Pollutant Load Monitoring
- <u>Sentinel Lakes Program</u> (DNR)
- Long-term biological monitoring of rivers and streams
- Local organizations


