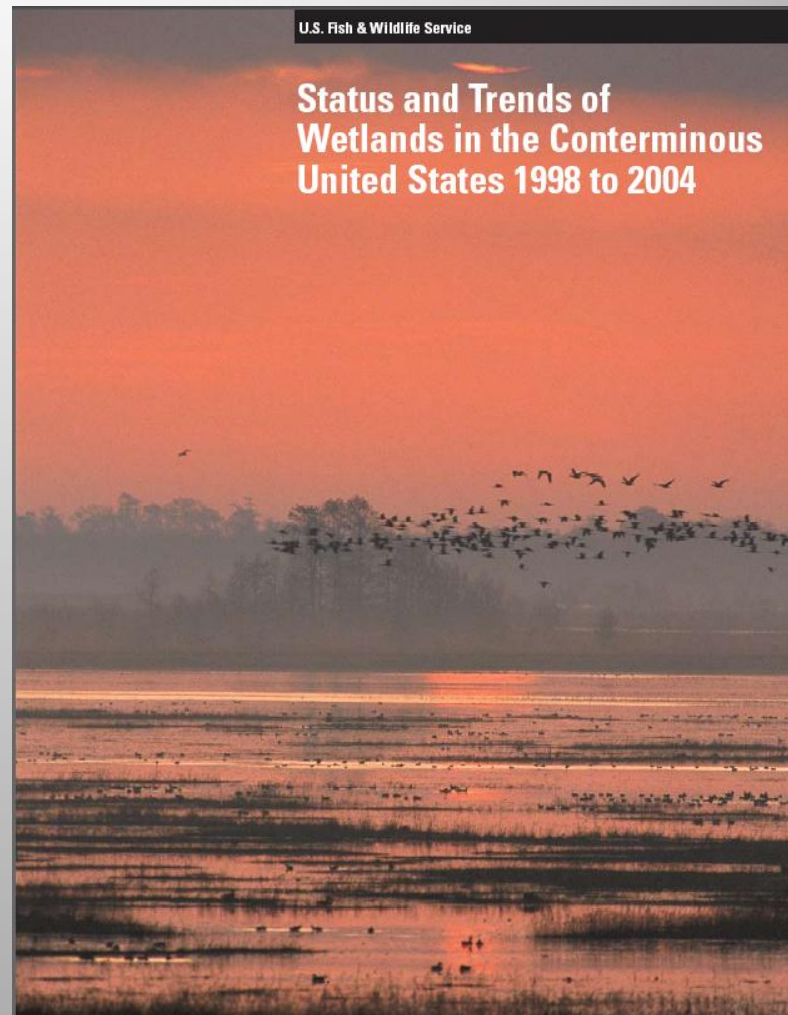
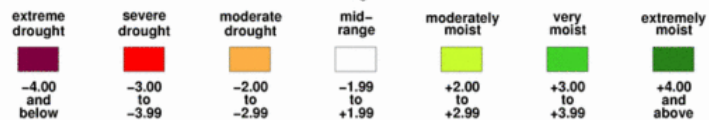
Status of Ducks

- The Food Security Act of 1985 (P.L. 99-198, also known as the 1985 [U.S. Farm Bill](#))



PFW Program



- Mission: To efficiently achieve voluntary habitat restoration on private lands, through financial and technical assistance, for the benefit of Federal Trust Species
- Statue: PUBLIC LAW 109–294—OCT. 3, 2006 120 STAT. 1351:
a.k.a – Partners for Fish and Wildlife Act (October 3, 2006);
SEC. 5. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS up to \$75,000,000 (~50,000,000 Nationally).
- Accomplishments:
 - Region 3 = \$7,300,000
 - HR Funds 2012= \$2,001,000
 - Partner Contributions: \$4,834,000

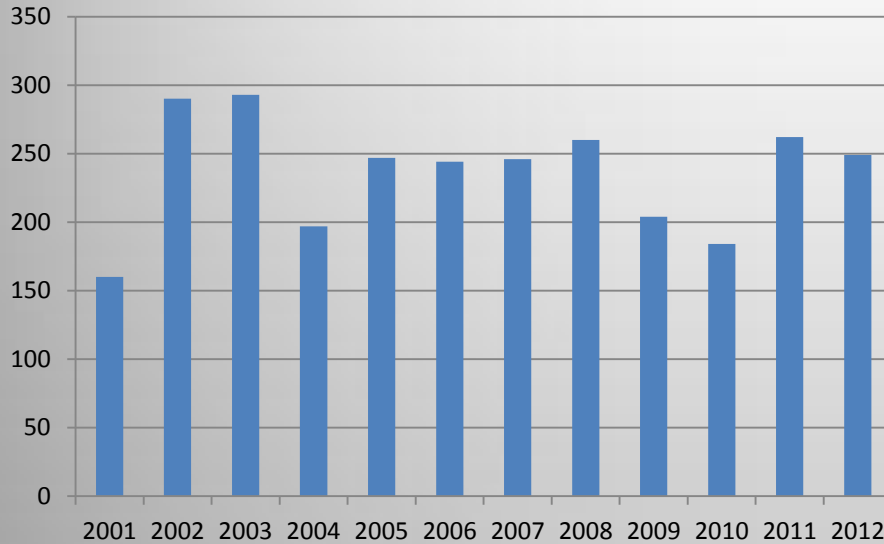
 - WI = Habitat Funds \$700,000
 - Partner Contributions: \$850,000



WI Partners Program Accomplishments 2001-2012

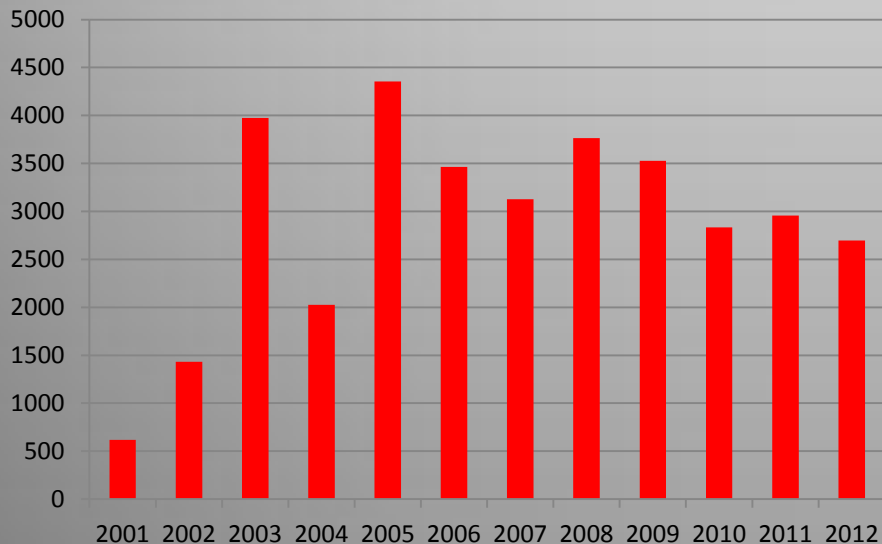

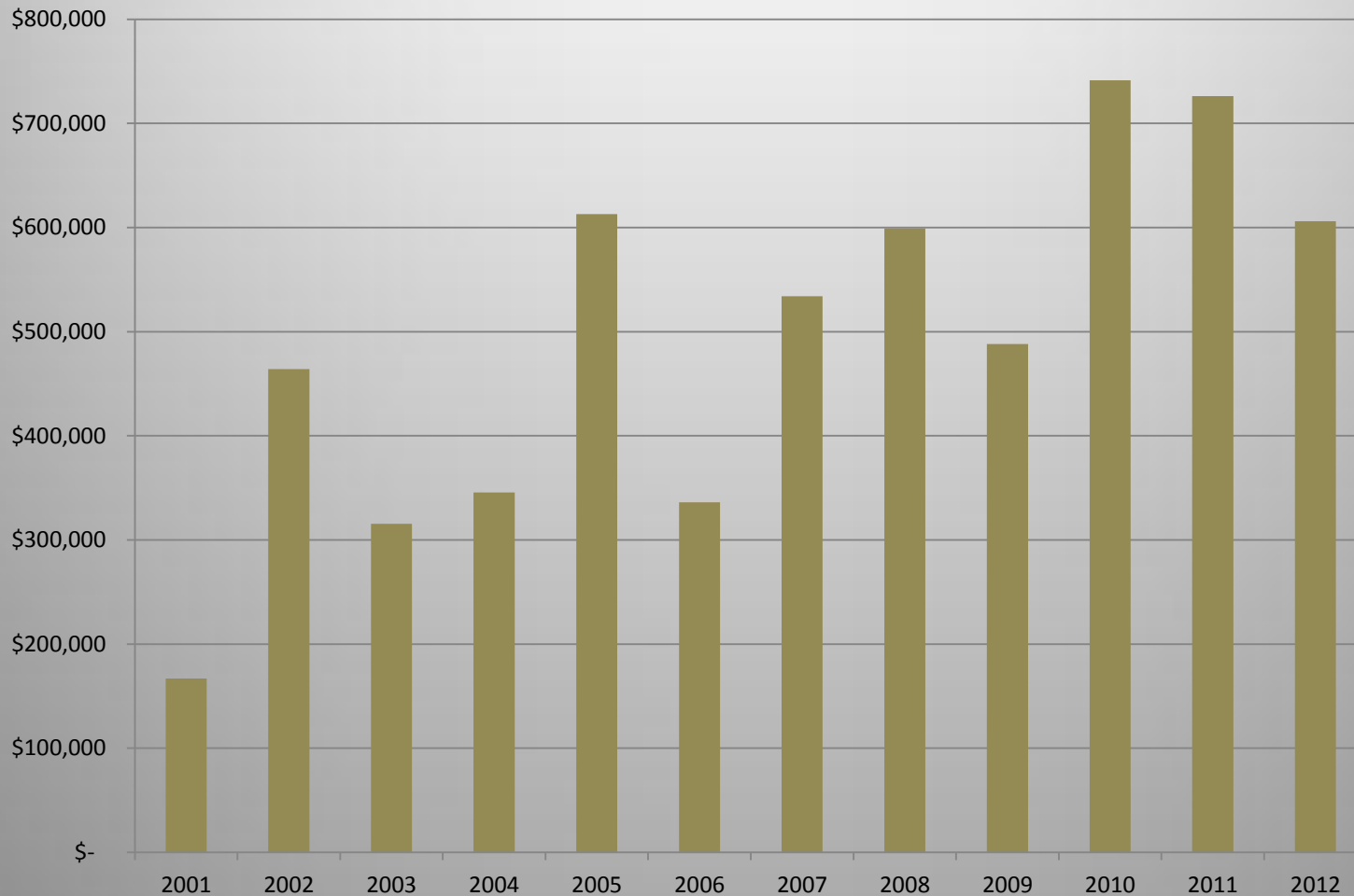

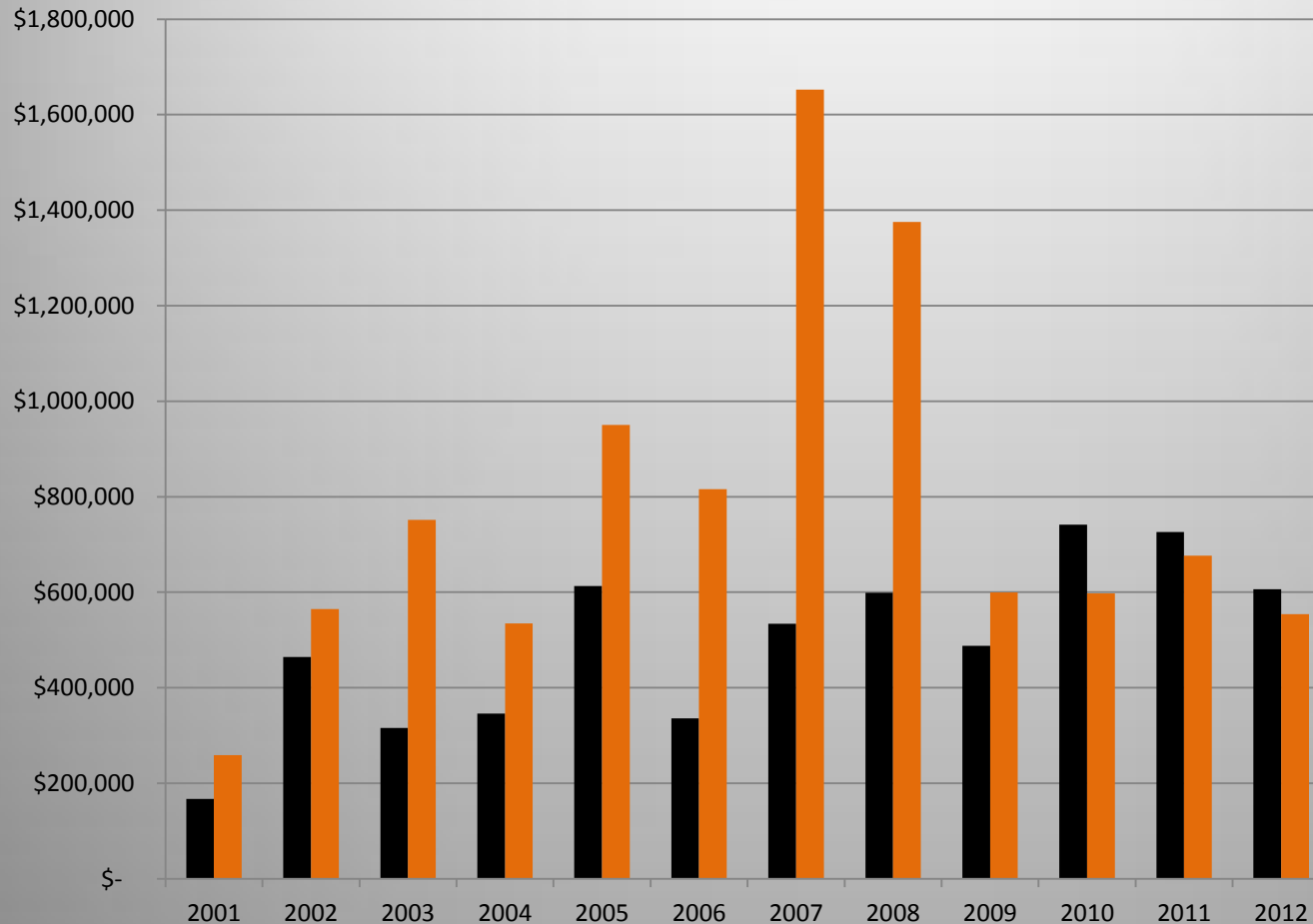


Wisconsin Partners Program Funding Levels 2001-2012

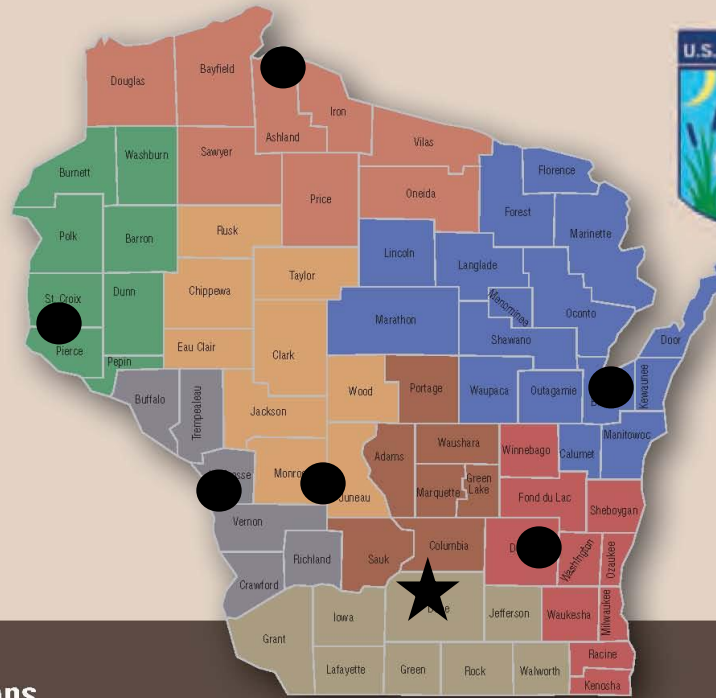

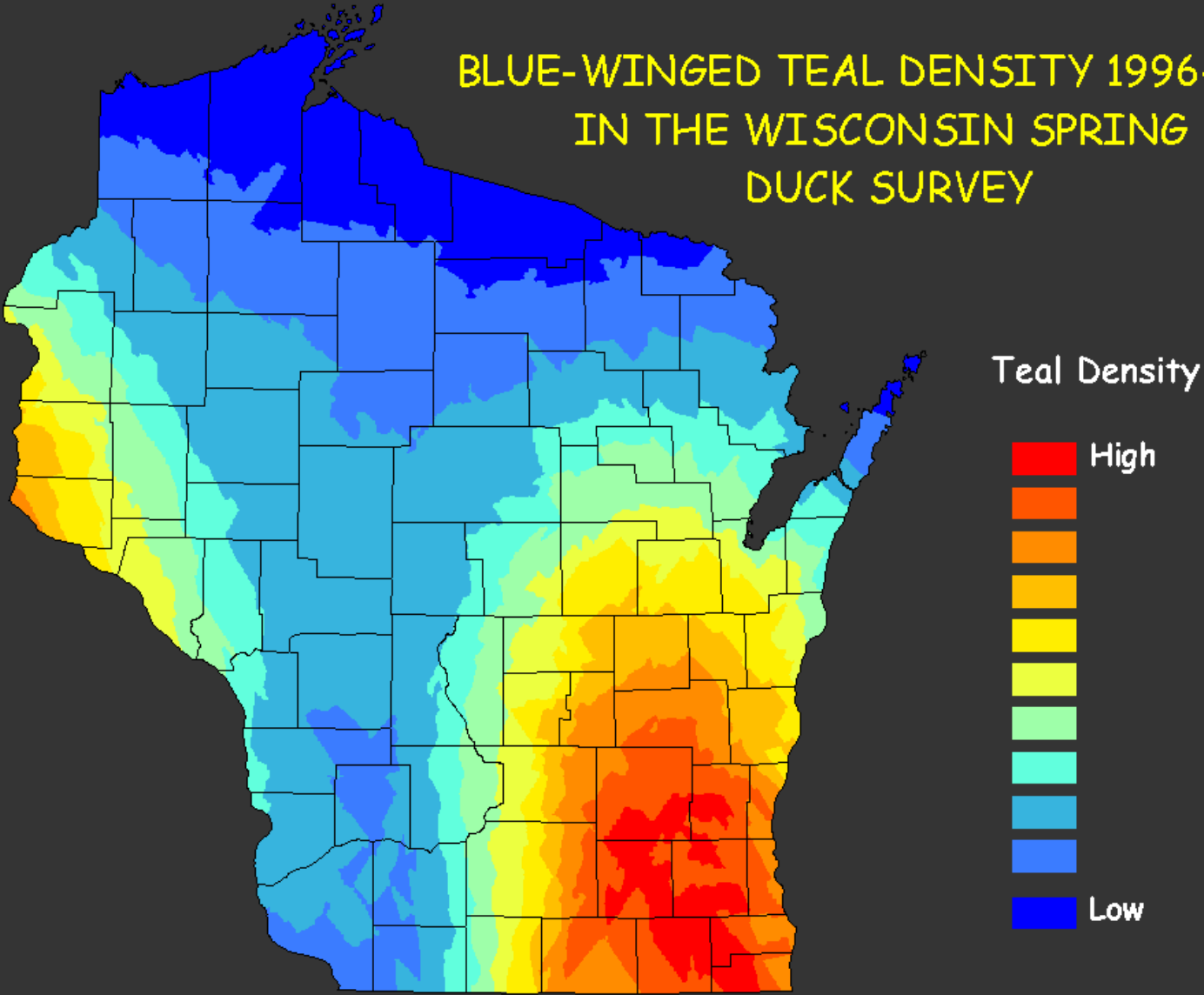

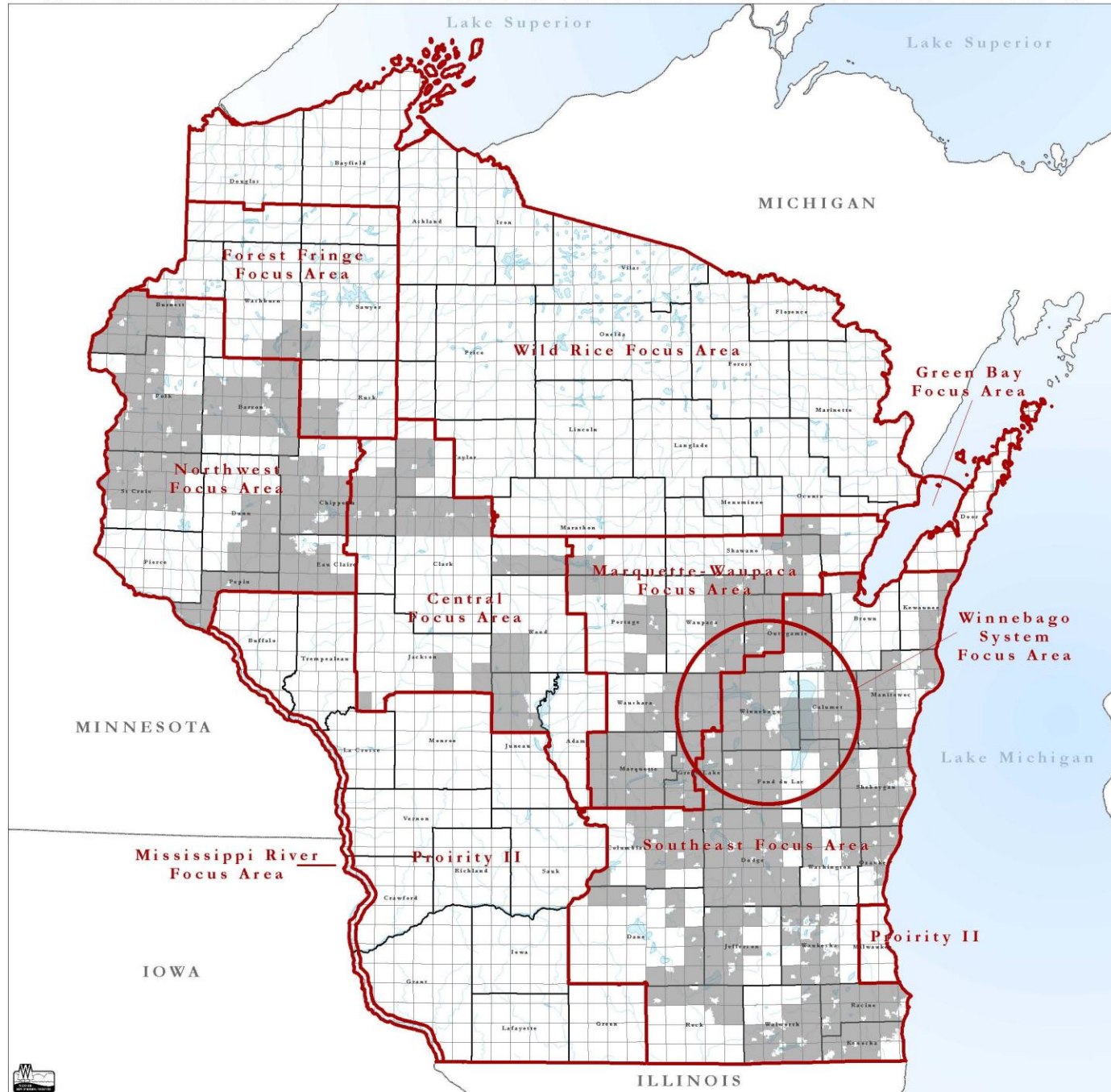
